How to get Landline / Broadband Telephone Bill On E-Mail

- Activation by Customer by Sending SMS at 53334 Customer can send SMS to 53334 with following format. EMS _<Billing_Account_Number> _<Email_Id> e.g. EMS 9000876534 abc@test.com
- Customer can log in to web self care portal http://selfcare.wdc.bsnl.co.in and place their request for getting telephone bill on "Email only" option .

 Procedure Click on active Account Number in My Account section. Then Choose Email option from dropdown list in billing preference and press "Submit Request" button.
- Customer can approach Customer Service Center and give request for "Email only" option.
- Customer can **approach BSNL Call Center by dialing 1500** and register number for e-bill.
